## NORTH TEXAS LEADERSHIP TRAINING FOR CHRIST



### Statement of Purpose

North Texas Leadership Training for Christ is a duly recognized association of youth groups of the Churches of Christ and parachurch youth groups affiliated with the Churches of Christ. The purpose of NTLTC is to plan, organize, promote, and execute programs that assist young Christians to develop their knowledge of the Bible and biblical principles, enhance their communication and leadership skills, and orient their energies and abilities to areas of Christian service.

### A Brief History of LTC

The first LTC Convention was held in Dallas, Texas in 1989. This convention has now expanded to three sites in the Dallas area. It became known as North Texas LTC in 1997 as other conventions were beginning. NTLTC has grown from 850 students at the first convention to over 6000 students. Other LTC conventions have begun in various parts of the country. For more information, look up [www.ntlctc.org](http://www.ntlctc.org).

Events fall into three categories: Preconvention, Challenge, and Convention. All Preconvention events ( audio broadcast, essay, fiction, power point, poetry, short film, song writing, video Bible drama, web page ) are completed

by the student prior to an early deadline and mailed in for judging. Challenge events (Bible reading, bulletin board, daily devotional, leadership, outreach, scripture, service, song leading, teaching ) are completed by the student at the home congregation and judged by the event coach with the results sent to the convention. Convention events (art—photography, sculpture, drawing, mixed media, Bible bowl, Bible reading, Bible quiz, children’s book, chorus, drama, puppets, scrapbook, signing for the deaf, song leading, speech) are participated in at the convention in Dallas. All event rules are listed on the website. Go check it out if you are wondering how an event is judged.

Our kids want to do it all!! There is a great need for coaches/mentors to help in many areas. Please look over the list of events and see if you can help in any way. Two areas lacking a coach are DRAMA and also PUPPETS. The students usually create their own script, but a mentors are needed to help guide the process. Get in contact with Coby Whitehead or Sarah Neff to see if there are students who need your help.

Another way to help is to pray! Pray for these kids who are studying God’s Word and learning to use it in creative and fun ways. They are thankful for your support!
